Fundamental Question 1	Which two passages (sentence or paragraph) of

Fundamental Question 2	Related to Question 1: How did your significant passages impact your thinking about your relationship with God and/or other people? If so, in what way?
Meeting A – January 26	Chapters Discussed: Chapter 1 and 2 (and sharing of communion)
Meeting B – February 2	Chapters Discussed: Chapters 3 through 5
Meeting C – February 16	Chapters Discussed: Chapters 6 through 8
Meeting D – February 23	Chapters Discussed: Chapters 9 through 11, Afterward (end of book)
